

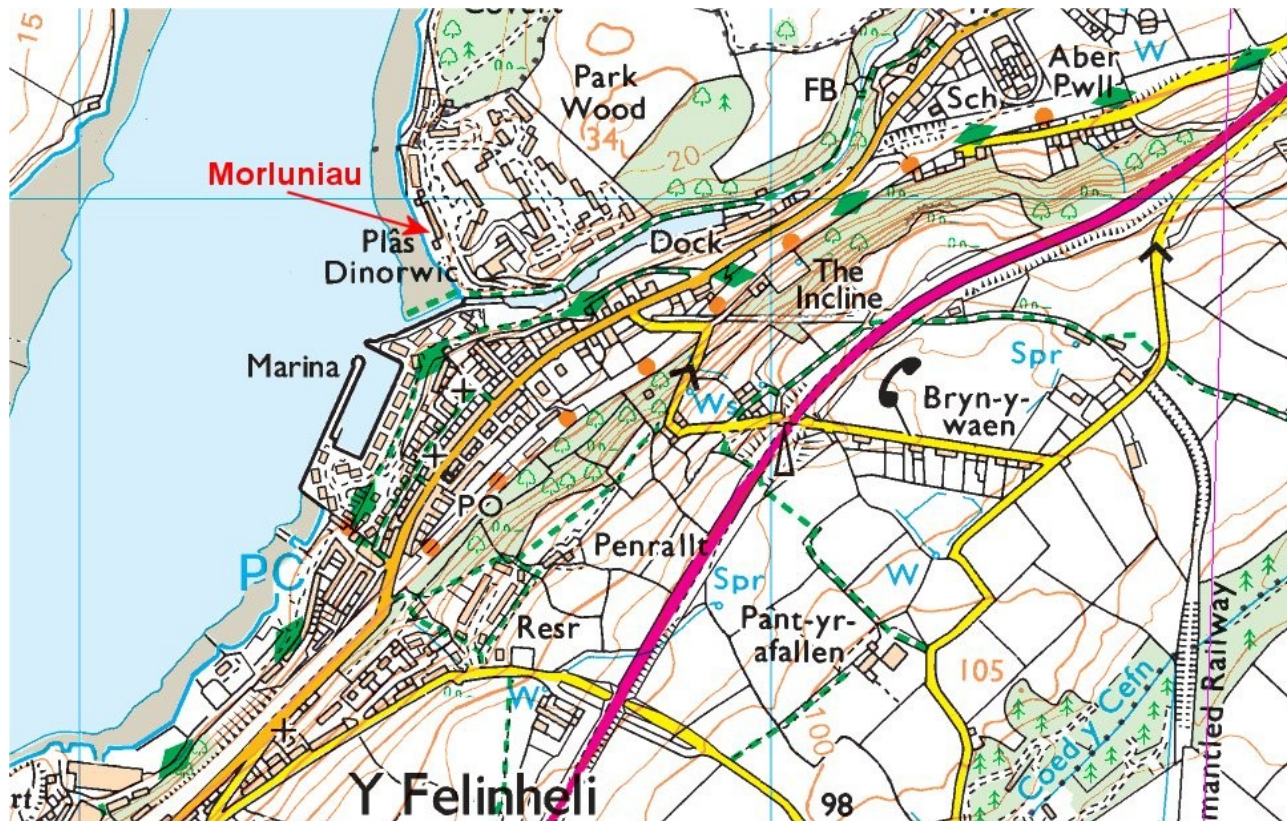

Take signs for “Marina” and “Caffi” the road is called “Hen Gei Llechi”. Turn Right across the Iron Bridge and go up the steep hill into the Estate.





This is what it looks like from the car park – the red arrow points to our kitchen!

When you arrive you may need to turn the water ON - two or three turns on this tap in the downstairs ensuite.

Remember to turn it off when you leave.



The downstairs ensuite bathroom has electric underfloor heating. If you need it, turn it on when you arrive and off when you leave.



The heating is controlled by the thermostat in the hall. It is usually on a schedule that should be comfortable but you can change it manually if you are too hot or too cold.

Kitchen

The smoke alarms are rather sensitive to cooking steam etc. If you set it off it can be cancelled by pressing the button – you may need to stand on a chair!



Extractor fan – there is an automatic extractor fan which comes on when it detects steam and goes off when the air is dry again.

Dishwasher – very simple, put a tablet in it, press ON, select Quick (it is probably already selected), press Start.



Bins – under-sink bin is for food waste and non-recyclable stuff. There are bin-bags in the cupboard to the right. Recyclables go in black bin under the clocks. The other black bin is doggy stuff – use and replace.

Recyclables are...

Plastic

Paper and cardboard

Glass

Tins and cans

These **must** be taken out to the bins in the car-park before you leave.

TV and Audio

The TV is Freesat, simply turn the TV on using the Samsung remote. Then turn on the Audio using the JVC remote (it should say AUX, if not change the source). You can stream music over Bluetooth too.

The **StairLift** if you need it...

This has an ON switch concealed on the left hand side by the wall which needs to be ON. Also there is a key labelled “stairlift” on the key hooks. Put the key in and turn it ON. Now you can use the lift by putting down the seat, armrests and footrests, and pressing the paddles on the ends of the armrests. There are also remotes, one on the key hooks and one upstairs. It’s fine to leave the stairlift switched on for the duration of your stay as this keeps the battery topped-up.

Internet

Consumables

Feel free use stuff in the cupboards/fridge/freezer if you want to, but please replace with similar before you go. Every-day stuff like tea bags, cooking oil, washing-up liquid, shampoo etc. just use it. If you break anything, try to replace it, or just tell us so we know. Treat it like your own home. If you find anything that needs fixing leave us a note, or if you get an emergency call us for advice.

Lights on timers

We have two table lights on timers. One in the main bedroom and one in the lounge. The timers make an annoying buzz so feel free to unplug these but remember to put them back before you leave.

Kayak canoes

You can use these entirely at your own risk! The paddles, seats and bouyancy aids are in the wardrobe in the main bedroom. The canoes are locked and the code is on the wall in the wardrobe. Please keep them locked up when not in use. Be advised that the current can be very strong in the straight. Slack tide is about an hour before high tide so going out around then is sensible and if you stick close to the shore you will be fine as there is only a small current here. There are waterproof phone cases hanging in the wardrobe too, so take your phone and note the marina number (01248 670176) in case you get into trouble. Respect the sea!

Inflatable dinghy

In the hall! Please do not use this.
